Setting up a Sub group on Freegle Direct

What is a sub group?

This is a named view for a specific category: gardening, child & baby etc
It does not change anything on your group, it runs the same way, you moderate the same way.
It is just another way to promote your group to particular local groups and organisations.
Eg. Allotments = gardening, Toddler groups = child and baby

You will need a Facebook page for your group and admin rights to create a named view.

Where do I start?



Named Views

Named Views are ways of presenting your group to different audiences, for specific categories.

To make changes to existing views, you need to be logged in to Freegle Direct using a Facebook user who is a Page Admin of the relevant group's Facebook page.

To make changes to existing views, you need to be logged in to Freegle Direct using a Facebook user who is a Page Admin of the relevant group's Facebook page.

You can create new named views for your group. The request will go to the Group Affiliation Team to check that the name is suitable. Once it is approved, you will get an email and you can then fill in other details.

Please put something relating to your location in the view name and shortlink, e.g. for a garden view EdinburghGrowYourOwn would be a good name.

What Happens Next?

Freegle Direct automatically sends your Named View request to the GAT Mailbox

Create View

It arrives looking like this:

Name: Edinburgh Grow Your Own Shortlink: EdinburghGrowYourOwn

Category: Gardening

GAT will look to see if it's a sensible group name. That there are spaces in the first name, a suitable shortlink and that the category matches.

If it's ok: GAT click on the link in this email to approve it and it whizzes off to the geeks who will make your group appear on our website here:

If it's not: GAT will send you a nice friendly email suggesting an edit, and ask you to request a named view again.

How do I personalise my sub group / named view?

You will receive an email confirmation with a link to your FD settings.

Scroll down to Named Views and it will now show text boxes to complete.

Type your group description here or copy another group's text and edit to suit.

Copy/Paste and edit your main group's FD sidebar text to suit.

Click Save Changes

The button will change to "Saved" in pale green


